There are now three generation of children who have learnt to read using Sunshine resources – at first using our printed books (both fiction and non-fiction) and now on digital devices.



Over the past two years we have reached into our archive and packaged two Take-Home Book Packs at special prices to match any budget. Teachers and parents have been delighted with these packs. We have been sure to include work by favourite authors such as Joy Cowley and John Carr. Later this year we will bring out a new Take-Home Book Pack 3 (levels 20–30) to bring to life many of the old favourites, loved by children and teachers.

- 2. Our new Take-Home Book Pack 3 (levels 20–30) mid-year.


IN 2021


Peter Stevenson




Real Stories

While the Sunshine Phonics books are decodable texts, they are also real stories! The stories follow the adventures of Nat, Dan and Sam and their pets and friends. All young children can relate to the fun storylines and always enjoy the humorous endings.

Words Children Can Read







Inside Front Cover

The inside front cover of each book provides the **Before**Reading focus for the children.
Here they will review the sounds they have learnt and practise blending those sounds to make the words that they will meet in the story.

Tricky Words are also reviewed as children will need to know these by sight at this stage.

Teaching Points: Discuss the use of speech and thought bubbles in this story to show the talking (speech) or thoughts of a character. Ask children to find examples in the book. Introduce the purpose of an exclamation mark to show emphasis. Review s on the end of a verb, e.g. hop/hops.

After Reading

Comprehension:

- · What are some of the things Dan did to get fit?
- · How was Sam helping Dan?
- . What was Sam holding in his hand? What does a stopwatch do?
- Can you think of other things you can do to help keep yourself fit?

Fluency: Speed read the words again from the inside front cover.

Bank of words using Set I sounds (45 words)

These words use Set 1 GPCs [Grapheme Phoneme Correspondence]. Because children already know these sounds, they can be helped to sound-talk through them for reading (blending the sounds tagether), e.g. /s//a//t/= sat. Sound-talk can also help children spell these words by starting with the whole word and then saying each sound – segmenting the sounds, e.g. sat = /s//a//t/. The words in red are high-frequency words.








The **Sunshine Starters** program focuses on the five essential skill areas that all students need to develop into successful readers. Evidence-based findings have identified these key areas as:

Phonemic Awareness – the ability to hear, identify and manipulate individual sounds (phonemes) in spoken language. Phonemes are the smallest units in spoken language and, when combined, create syllables and words. Phonemic awareness is an important foundation skill needed for learning to read, write and spell. There are 44 phonemes in the English language and they are taught within the Sunshine Starters program.

Phonics – understanding the relationship between written letters (graphemes) and the sounds in spoken language (phonemes). There are 26 letters in the English language that in isolation or in combination with each other create the 44 sounds. The Sunshine Starters program explicitly teaches these letter-sound relationships so that students can learn how to decode words by blending and segmenting the sounds. Students will also learn many of the different graphemes used in English to represent the same sound.

Vocabulary – developing an ever-increasing base of known words and their meaning. Vocabulary is important in reading as the more words students know and understand, the easier it is for them to make sense of what they are reading. While a student's vocabulary develops indirectly, focused discussion of the vocabulary featured in the book they are reading provides an authentic context in which to expand their knowledge. Vocabulary development is included in the Sunshine Starters teaching plans.

Comprehension – ability to understand and make meaning from text. Successful readers implement different strategies while they are reading in order to make sense of the text. Strategies to support comprehension are taught with each Sunshine Starters book and include:

- Asking and answering questions
- Making connections by activating and using prior knowledge
- Making predictions before, during and after reading
- Summarising
- Inferencing

Fluency – ability to read at pace with accuracy and expression. Being able to read fluently aids comprehension. Students who are unable to read fluently will be slow and laboured, may have problems with decoding and are most likely to be frustrated and unmotivated. The Sunshine Starters program supports student's fluency development through modelling, choral reading and practised re-reading.



Sound Structure

All titles have been carefully levelled using reading recovery criteria so that the gradient of difficulty supports beginning readers. Careful consideration is given to the size and spacing of the text, the connection between illustration and text and also the complexity of the language and sentence structures.

Guided Reading

Sunshine Starters has been created as a guided reading program and is supported by explicit teaching notes. These notes ensure that the five pillars of reading are covered.
